

March Anno Domini 1812

- 5th To see, if the Town, will give liberty for Sheep to go at Large, from the 15th Day of March, to the first day of May Next,
- 6th To see, if the Town, will accept the Settlement of the selectmen, with the Town Treas^r and Order the same to be recorded,
- 7th To act upon the 3^d article, in the warning of November Meeting and refer^d, to March Meeting, for further consideration
- 8th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable person, or persons, for collector, or, collectors, to collect the taxes assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for the year ensuing, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Met,
- 9th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable persons for a School Committee, & authorize them to agree with, and hire School Instructors, to instruct the public Schools in said Town the year ensuing, to do or act &c &c
- 10th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for the purpose of procuring Preaching in said Town, for the future, to do or act, &c &c
- 11th To see, if the Town will express their Minds respecting the Town of Concord, being the Shire Town in the County of Middlesex, in Preference to any other Town, in said County that has petitioned the Legislature of this Commonwealth, for the same, to do or act &c &c
- 12th To see, if the Town, will appoint an agent to appear in behalf of said Town, at the Court of Common Pleas Next to be holden at Concord at March term Next to prevent Nahum Tower, obtaining a bill of Cost against P^r. Town, to do or act &c
