adjusting all such accounts, as shall be brought
against the Town, for services done, or Materials
found in behalf of said Town, to do, or act &c &c

14th To see, if the Town, will choose three or more Su-
-stable persons for the purpose of Superintending
the Inoculation of the Inhabitants of said Town
with the Cow Pox, agreeable to an act of the General
Court Passed March 5th 1810, to Do - or act &c &c

this warrant, with your doings thereon, to one of the
Selectmen, by the time of the Opening said Meet-
-ing
