3rd Article, pass'd in the Negative

6th Accepted the Settlement of the Selectmen, with
the Town Treat, and ordered the same to be
Recorded, which is as it stands hereafter recorded

7th the 3rd article in the warning of Nov^r Meeting and
refer'd, to March Meeting as Contain'd, in this 7th Arti-
-cle put over to April Meeting

8th The Town by their Vote Directed their Selectmen to
agree with some suitable person, or persons, to perform
the service express'd in this article and to report to
the Town of their proceedings at April Meeting

9th Voted, to appoint a School Com^{tee} for the purposes ex-
-press'd under this article, said Com^{tee} to consist
of five and to be chosen by ballot, and the following
Gent^l were chosen Viz - Eben^r Plympton Esq^r Capt^r
Isaac Gibbs, Mr. Joel Balcom Mr. Jed^d Thompson
and Capt^r Israel Haynes

Also the Town Invested sd^d Com^{tee} with the same pow-
-ers and authority the School Com^{tee} were invested with
the year past, Also Established the same rules, orders &
Discipline, that were to be observed in each respective
School the past year

Then Mr. Balcom wish'd to be excus'd, from serving
on said Com^{tee}, & being put to vote pass'd in the Negative

Then Mr. Balcom, excus'd, himself from serving

10th Voted to take Measures to procure preaching in sd^d Town
also Voted to appoint a Com^{tee} for to procure preach-
-ing during the Towns pleasure, and the Selectmen were
chosen for the purpose aforesaid

11th put over to April Meeting
