- 2^d To bring in their Votes, for the Choice of some Suitable Person, for a County Treas^r
- 3^d To fill up Vacancies, in those Town Offices, which the Law requires, should any Office appear to be Vacant,
- 4th To see, if the Town, will act upon the 3rd Article in the warning of Nov^r Meeting & refer to March Meeting and so on to April Meeting - also the 11th 13th & 14th Articles in the Warning of March Meeting and refer to April Meeting for further Consideration,
- 5th To see, if the Town, will take Measures for the purpose of procuring some Suitable Person, or Persons, to preach in said Town, during the Towns Pleasure to do, or act, as the Town, shall think proper when Met,
- 6th To see if the Town, will give any Instructions to their Selectmen, respecting their letting out the Poor, belonging to said Town, for the Year ensuing to Do - or act - &c &c
- 7th To see, if the Town, will appropriate, all the unappropriated Money now in the Treasury, for the purpose of defraying the expence that has or may arise in consequence of hiring of preaching, - to Do - or act &c &c
- 8th To see, if the Town will give Liberty for Neat Cattle, to go at large the Present Year, - to Do - or act &c &c
- 9th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of Building two Stone Stone ways, on the New road, below Lieut^t Joshua Haynes, it being agreeable to the request of Capt^t Israel Haynes, to do - or - act. &c &c
- 10th To see, if the Town will, agreeable to the request of M^r Eben^r Parmenter, take some Measures, for the purpose of compelling their Highway Surveyors in said Town, to work out their Taxes, Committed
