Then voted, to adjourn this Meeting to this day
week, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon to meet at
this place

Sudbury Monday April 13th 1812 The Town being
Met agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, proceeded
to the business of said day, and took up the 2^d Article

as one of the School Committee — then Mr Ab^l Osborn
wish'd to be exc^{sd} from serving Highway Surveyor, & be-
ing put to vote, pass'd in the Negative, then he refus'd
serving

Attend'd to the report, of their Com^{tee} appointed at March
Meeting for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable per-
son to collect the Taxes Assess'd upon the Inhabitants of said
Town, for the year ensuing. an Express in the 8th Art^{le} — who
Reported that they had agreed with Mr. Walter Haynes at four
and an half Mills, on the Dollar for Collection, (provided
he can have the benefit of being chosen Constable, for the
Town, — accept'd said Report —

3^d made choice of Mr. Walter Haynes for their Constable
for the year ensuing

Then the Town Exc^{sd} Mr. Ab^l Osborn from serving High-
way Surveyor, & Mr. Joseph Hemmerson was cho-
sen in his room — also —
