8th Article Passed in the Negative

9th The Town by their Vote, Directed the Surveyor of Highways in the N^o west Ward to purchase the Stone upon the best terms he can Sufficient to cover the Shueways Mentioned in this article, — the labor in transporting said Stone and building said Shuways, to be done towards Highway work and the expense of purchasing the Stone, to be brought in to the Town, for allowance at the Debt & Credit Meeting,

5th Then the Town took up this article again, and Voted to give their Committee Instructions which were chosen under this article, — The Question was then put to see if the Town would Instruct their Committee to procure six Months preaching, three Months of said term to be by Mr. Randal and the other three Months by the best person they can procure, which being put to vote, it passed in the affirmative — — by 64 to 56,

— The Question was then put, to see if, their Committee should Engage Mr. Randal to preach the Next Sabbath, & so on the term of three Months as was Voted, and it passed in the Negative, by 64 to 63,

10th The Town by their Vote, Directed the Surveyor of Highways in said Town, to return all such persons as were Delinquent in working out their taxes, to the Assessors at the expiration of the term of time, for which they were chosen, in order to be put into the next Town tax to be assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town,

— Then the Town by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting,
