having a freehold Estate within said Town, of the an=
nual Income of three Pounds, or any Estate to the va=
lue of sixty Pounds, to Meet, at the Meeting House in
said Town, on Monday the 4th Day of May next, at 1.
o'clock in the Afternoon, for the purpose of Choosing a
Representative to Represent them in the General Court
appointed to be convened and held at Boston, on the
Last Wednesday of May, next.

previous to the Opening said Meeting
