Report to the Town their Opinion, respecting the
repairs that are necessary, and the probable expense &c

11th Passed in the Negative

12th the Committee appointed, for the purpose of
looking out a suitable spot of ground, for a bury-
ing yard, Reported, that they could purchase One
acre of Land of M^r. Walter Haynes, adjoining the bu-
rying place, for \$200. & that they could purchase of
Capt. Jon^a. Bent on the Hill near the Meeting House
a piece of land containing about 4 acres for about
\$250, &c &c

8th then the Town took up this article again and Gra-
nted, the sum of \$200, for the purpose of
Defraying the expense, of hiring preaching
for the year ensuing \$200,

10th article attended to the report of their Com^{tee}
appointed to examine the Duck, who report-
ed they had attended to examining the Duck &c
and it appeared to be leaky, in a number of places
and of course must rot Down in a short time
if measures were not taken to prevent it

Then the Town by their Vote Directed their Com^{tee}
to proceed immediately, to make such repairs as
they shall think Necessary to be made, in order
to prevent said Duck, from any further Decay, by rea-
son of Leakage

Also Granted, the sum of \$200, for the purpose
of repairing the Bell duck, and repairing Shermans
Bridge, said Com^{tee} to be accountable to the Town
for the expenditure of the same \$200,
