Pursuant to the within warrant, I have Notified and warned the Inhabitants of Sudbury aforesaid, to assemble at the time & place and for the purposes within mentioned.

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on Thursday the 28th Day of May 1812 provided & took up the 1st article and 1st made choice of Capt. Isaac Gibbs, for their Moderator,

2^d article Granted by way of a bounty as an encouragement to this Towns proportion of Soldiers, which are called upon by Government to hold themselves in readiness at the shortest notice the sum of two dollars p^r Man, the Number being eighteen amounting to \$36.

— Also Voted as an encouragement to give to each Soldier aforesaid the sum of One Dollar, & twenty five cents p^r Day for every Day that they are called upon, and actually do duty under their respective Officers under which they shall be enrolled, until such time as they are called upon, by Government to go into actual service

— Also Voted, to give to each and every Soldier aforesaid, as an encouragement, the sum of Seven dollars per Month, (in addition to
