Sudbury Monday September 14. 1812

At a Town Meeting Legally held, in Sudbury, on the Day
and Year aforesaid, provided to the business of said Day,
and took up the 1st article, and made choice of William
Hunt Esq^r for their Moderator.

2^d article, Voted, to appoint two persons, as agents, to appear
in behalf of said Town, at the Circuit Court of Com-
mon Pleas, as Express in this article, (if they shall deem it
Necessary) said agents, to have discretionary powers, to act
in said business, as they shall Judge, will be most to
the Interest of the Town. — Also Voted, that the agents
aforesaid, are empowered to act, either, in Corporate, or se-
parate Capacity, as circumstances render Necessary
and William Hunt Esq^r & Deacon Walker were Appo-
inted, for the purposes, above mentioned.

3^d article The Town by their Vote, appointed the Selectmen, as
a Committee, in behalf of the Town, for the purpose of ridding
said Town from the Support, of the Widow Elizabeth Pine
&c, as Express in this article, said Com^{tee} to be Vested with
Discretionary power, to act in said business, as they shall
Judge, will be most conducive to the Interest, of the
Town. — Also Voted, the Com^{tee} aforesaid, are fully au-
thorized & empowered, to act, either in a Corporate, or
separate Capacity, as the Cause may appear Necessary.

4th The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town would
Grant a suitable Sum of Money, for the purpose
mentioned in this article, & it pass'd in the Negative.

Then the Town by their Vote Dissolved
