To Mr. Walter Haynes, Constable, of the Town of Sud-
bury, in the County of Middlesex, — Greeting —

LS } You are hereby, required, in the Name of the
LS } Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify, and
LS } warn, the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants of said
LS } Town, Qualified by Law, to Vote, in Town Meetings to
assemble at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on
Monday the 2^d Day of November Next, at 2 o'clock
in the afternoon, on said Day, then and there
to act on the following, articles, Vizt. —

1st To Choose a Moderator, —

2^d To see, if the Town, will take some suitable Mea-
sures, for the purpose of procuring preaching in
said Town, during such term of time the Town a-
grees upon, and appropriate a sufficient sum of
Money, out of any unappropriated Money, as shall de-
fray the expence of hiring the same, to do or act
as the Town shall think, most proper when Met. —

3^d To see, if the Town, will discount, to Constable Wal-
ter Haynes, such taxes, as he holds against certain
poor persons, belonging to said Town, as appears to
be unable to pay the same, to do or, act &c &c

of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to One
of the Selectmen, previous to the opening said Meeting
