

November Anno Domini 1812.

At a Town Meeting Legally held in Sudbury on Monday the
2^d Day of November 1812, provided and took up the
1st Article and made choice of Col^l. Jon^a. Rice for their
Moderator,

2^d art^l. the Question was put, to see, if the Town would take any
Measures, for to procure some suitable person to preach, for the
term of six sabbaths, which being put to vote, it passed in the
affirmative, — It was then mov'd, to see, if the Town would
make application to Mr. Partman of Boston, and if he can-
not be obtain'd, to some other person that belongs below, to
preach the six sabbaths, which being put to vote passed
in the negative

— It was then put to vote to see, if the Town would apply
to Mr. Randall, to supply the pulpit the six sabbaths, — as
above agreed upon, and it passed, in the affirmative —
by 45 to 38. — also by their vote, appointed the select-
men, as a Com^{tee}, for the purpose of making application
to Mr. Randall, to supply the pulpit, for the term a-
bove mentioned,

mainder part, of this article, to the next
