To Mr. Walter Haynes, Constable, of the Town of Sud-
bury, in the County of Middlesex — Greeting

That You are hereby required, in the name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to notify &
warn, the freeholders, and other Inhabitants,
of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified by law, to

Note in Town Meetings,
to assemble at the Meeting-House in Said Town
on Monday, the 1st Day of March Next, at 10,
o'clock, in the forenoon, on Said Day then &
there to act on the following articles, Viz.

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen,
Town Treasurer, Assessor, Constables, and all
Other Town officers, required by law, to be
annually chosen, in the Months of March, or
April

2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their High-
ways, by a rate, the present year, and Grant
a suitable Sum of Money, for repairing the
same

3^d To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for
Swine, to go at large, the present year,

4th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for
Horses, and Mules, to go at large, the present
year

5th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for
kneat Cattle, to go at large, the present year

6th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for
Sheep, to go at large, from the 15th Day of
March, to the 1st Day of May Next,

7th To see, if the Town, will accept the settle-
ment of the Selectmen, with the Town
Treas^r, and order the same to be recorded —
