8th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for the Purpose of agreeing with some suitable person, or Persons, to collect the Taxes, assaid, upon the Inhabitants, of Said Town, for the year ensuing to, do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Mett,

9th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable Persons, for a school Committee, and authorize them to agree with, and hire School-Instructors, to instruct the Public Schools, in Said Town, the year ensuing — to Do, or, act &c.

10th To see, if the Town, will appoint, an agent, or agents, to appear in behalf of Said Town, at the Middle Circuit Court, of Common Pleas, Next to be holden at Concord, on the 2^d Monday of March Next, to answer to an Indictment, for Neglecting to repair the Highway, from Mr. Ezekiel H. Loring, to Mr. Elijah Moore, to, do, or, act &c.

11th To see, if the Town, will take any, and if any, what Measures, they will take for the purpose, of procuring some suitable Person to supply the Desk in Said Town, during such term, of time as the Town, shall agree, upon to do — or act any other way, on this article as the Town shall think best when Mett,

12th To see, if the Town, will lay out a bridge way from Capt. Bernts Causeway so called beginning on the westerly Side of Robbins's Hill (so called,) it being for the benefit of the Proprietors of the Gulf Meadows! — It being agreeable to the Petition of Mr. Silas Grant & others, reference therunto being had, to do, or act &c &c
