5th Article passed in the Negative

6th Passed in the Negative

7th put over to April Meeting to be acted upon

8th Voted, that the Selectmen, take such Measures, as they shall think best, for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable person, or persons, to collect the Taxes apportioned upon the Inhabitants of said Town, as expressed in this article, and report to the Town their proceedings, at April Meeting, next ensuing

9th Voted, to appoint a ^{School} Committee, for the purpose expressed in this article, said Com^{tee} to consist of five one to be taken out of each school district, and to be chosen by Ballot, & the following Gentlemen were chosen, Viz^t for Centre district, Capt. Nahum Goodnow, S. W. district Mr. Jeduthan Willis, S. E. Mr. John Goodnow, for N. E. Deacon Sam^l Puffer, & S. W. Mr. Abel Dakin, — then Mr. Jeduthan Willis declined serving on said Com^{tee} & Mr. Asa Willis was chosen in his stead

— Also, the Town Invested said Com^{tee} with the same Powers and authority, the School Com^{tee} were Invested with the year past, — also established the same Rules, orders and discipline that were to be observed, in each & every School the year last past

10th The Town, by their Vote, appointed Mr. Nathaniel Goodnow, as an agent, to appear in behalf of said Town, at the Middle next Court, of Common pleas, Next to be holden at Concord, on the 2^d Monday of 293.1 March
