3rd Article Mr. Asa Willis Requested to be excused, from serving as one of the School Com^{tee} & being put to vote pass'd in the negative, — then Mr. Willis excused himself from serving — & Mr. Joel Balcom was appointed in his stead, —

4th the 7th article in the warning of March Meeting contained in this 4th article, — accepted the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r and Ordered the same to be recorded, —

— Attended to the report of the Selectmen, who were appointed in March last, for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable Person, or Persons, to collect the taxes, assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for the year ensuing — who reported, that they had agreed, with Mr. Ezekiel H. Loring for five Mills, on the Dollar, for the collection, of the whole of the taxes assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for the year ensuing, Provided he can have the Privilege of being chosen Constable —

3rd Article Then the Town made choice of Mr. Walter Haynes for their Constable for the year ensuing, who has since been sworn to the faithful discharge of his office, by the Clerk of the Town.

5th The Town, by their Vote, authorized their Surveyors of Highways, to collect the Money of those persons who shall refuse or neglect to work out their Highway taxes upon the roads, when called upon by their respective Surveyors, as Express'd in this article —
