3^d To see, if the Town, will Grant to their Rev^d. Minister, his Salary, for the year ensuing, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Mett.

4th To see, if the Town will Grant Money for the support of a Grammar School, for the year ensuing, and order where the same shall be kept, to do, or act &c

5th To see, if the Town will grant Money, for the support of a Reading and writing school, for the year ensuing, and order where the same shall be kept, to do, or act &c

6th To see, if the Town will Grant Money, for the relief of the Poor, belonging to said Town, for the year ensuing

7th To see, if the Town will Grant Money, to pay their Tax^s and Assessors, for the present year, to do - or act &c

8th To see, if the Town will Grant a suitable sum of Money, for the purpose of defraying the expense of hiring Preaching, for the year ensuing, to do, or act &c

9th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable person to take care of, and sweep the Meeting-House, ring the Bell, and dig graves, as occasion may require, for the year ensuing, to do - or act, &c

10th To see if the Town, will accept the list of Jurors, as presented by the Selectmen, to do - or, act &c

11th To see, if the Town will accept of a road, as Laid out by the Selectmen, upon the easterly side of Cold-brook Camway (so called) Near Capt. Jon^s Bents, it being for the accommodation of Mess^{rs}. Simon H. & Daniel Whaler and others, to their Gulf Meadow lots, to do - or, act &c

12th To see, if the Town will direct their Surveyor of Highways in the North west district, to Open the road leading from the School-House in the North-west district by Mr. Abel Baborn, to the County road Near Mr. Wil-
liam Smiths, agreeable to the Original laying out to - do - or act &c

13th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable sum of Money, to defray the expense of a ringing school it
