Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the Inhabitants of Sudbury, aforesaid Qualified as the law directs, to Assemble at the time and place, and for the purposes within Mentioned —

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury, on Monday the 3^d Day of May 1813, — Proceeded to the business of the Day, and took up the 1st Article — and

1st made choice of Colo^l Jonathan Rice for their Moderator,

2^d Art^{le} brought in accounts, as stand hereafter recd —

3^d Granted as a salary to the Rev^d Mr. Bigelow the sum of \$246.67. for the year ensuing —

4th Granted, for the support of a grammar school for the year ensuing, the sum of \$375 to be equally Divided between the five School districts —

5th Granted, for the support of a reading and writing school, for the year ensuing —
