3^d To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for the purpose of making a demand upon the Inhabitants of the Town of Lincoln, for the support of John Olivers family, being paupers, and now residing in the Town of Sudbury, but whose legal Settlement is supposed to be in said Town of Lincoln, and Grant a suitable Sum of Money, for carrying on the same, to do, or act, &c

4th To see, if the Town will agreeable to the request of M^r Benjamin Rice, assist him in defending a suit Instituted against him by L^t Peter Smith, for his proportion of land, out of his brother Israel Smiths Estate to, do, or act &c

5th To see if the Town will Grant Money, to make up the deficiency in the Grant made in May last for to answer the Bill of cost taxed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for a bad road, in the southerly part of said Town, to, do, or act &c

6th To see if the Town, will Grant a suitable Sum of Money to defray the expence of an Indictment, &c by the circuit court of Common Pleas, against the Inhabitants of said Town, for Neglecting to erect Guide posts, on the public roads, agreeably to law.

7th To see, if the Town, will appoint an agent, to appear in behalf of the Inhabitants of said Town, at the Court of Sessions, next to be holden at Concord, within & for the County of Middlesex, on the 3^d Tuesday of September next, to shew cause if any they have why the Prayer of the Petition of Daniel Wheeler, for a Road, near Capt. Jon^a Bents, should not be granted, to, do, or act, &c
