3^d To see, if the Town will agreeable to the request of
Capt. Israel Haynes, Grant a suitable sum of Mo=
=ney, for the purpose of purchasing a sufficient Num=
=ber of Stone, suitable to cover Shueways in the
different parts of the Town, where they shall be, ne=
=eded, ^{Judge}
