Stone to be transported by the Inhabitants of the district in which they are to be laid, and to answer in part, towards their Highway tax & pass, in the affirmative, - also voted that said Committee should consist of eight, two to be taken out of each District, Committee appointed were, for N.E. District Eben^r. Plympton Esq^r & Capt. Israel Haynes, N.W. Ward, Mr. Asa Balcom & Mr. Levi Smith, S.E. Ward Mr. John Goodnow, & Mr. John Stone, S.W. Ward Mr. Sam^l. Knight & Capt. Isaac Gibbs - also voted that said Committee, see that the Stone to cover said Shewways be procured this fall, and transported by sliding to the several places where they shall be wanted to be Laid, and also that the Comm^{tee} shall transmit an account of the Value of the Stone, and the expence of the transport agreed upon (to the Next Surveyors of Highways) of such persons as they have purchased, & agreed with for the transport, in order that they may be allowed, by said Surveyors, in their Highway taxes N.B. the transport of the Stone to be by the district in which the Stone are Laid, - - - - -
4th Granted the sum of \$55.00 for the purpose of making up the deficiency of the Towns stock of ammunition, as mentioned in this article - - - - - \$55.00
2^d article, The Town took up this article again, & by their vote referred said article to the Next Town Meeting - - -
