At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 20th Day of September 1813, I provided to the business of said Day, by taking up the 1st article, and made choice of William Hunt Esq^r for their Moderator, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

2^d Article the 2^d article in the morning of Sept^r 6th Meeting and referred to the next Town Meeting, was by vote put over to March Meeting, — the 6th article in the morning of August 9th Meeting & referred to Sept^r 6th Meeting and so on to the next Town Meeting — Granted the sum of \$27.94 to defray the Expense, of the Bill of cost for not erecting guide boards in said Town, agreeable to law \$27.94

3^d Article, then the Town by their vote provided to fill up the vacancy of Town Treas^r. and William Hunt Esq^r was chosen, (instead of Capt. Joseph Goodnow Deceased) for the remainder of the year, and was sworn into office Oct^r 14, by the Clerk of said Town, — then provided to the choice of an assessor in the room of Capt. J. Goodnow Deceased & Mr. John Goodnow Jun^r was chosen, and has since been sworn into office, by the Clerk of said Town, — then Voted to fill up the vacancy of a Committee Man as expressed in this article, said person to be chosen by ballot, and Lemuel Hopstille Willis was chosen, in the room of Capt. Goodnow Deceased ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
