1st To Choose a Moderator,

2^d To see, if the Town will prefer a petition to the Legislature of this Commonwealth, to Enact a Law, for making the Town of Concord the Shire Town, of Middlesex County, in order that the several courts, and public records, may be held and kept there in future; — also to see if the Town will Instruct their Representative, to use his influence in order to carry the same into effect, it being agreeable to a circular letter from a Committee appointed by the Inhabitants of the Town of Concord, directed to the Selectmen of Sudbury, — reference thereunto being had, to do or act as the Town shall think best when met,

3^d To see, if the Town, will take any Measures to confer with the church of Christ, in this place, for the purpose of hearing any Candidate, as a preacher, on probation to do or act as the Town shall think best when met,

— Hereof you are not to fail of making return of this Warrant with your doings thereon, to some one of the Selectmen previous to the Opening said Meeting
