It was then voted, to reconsider the vote last past, —
— also voted, that the Committee aforesaid, should to
have a conference with Mr. Hilliard as it respects giving
him a call to settle with us as our Minister &c. & to re-
— port to the Town at some future Meeting, —

— Then voted, to adjourn this Meeting to — this
Day week at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, to meet at

The Town being met, at time & place agreeable to the
foregoing adjournment, proceeded as follows. 1st to attend
to the report of their committee appointed on Monday last
for the purpose of waiting on Mr. Hilliard, to give him
a call, to settle with them as their Minister, ^{in Colhague} — which
report is as follows, — Your Committee appoint-
— ed on Monday last, for the purpose of waiting on Mr.
Hilliard, &c. beg leave to report, — that we have attend-
— ed to that service, & have proposed, to give Mr. Hilli-
— ard, \$500. Settlement; — \$500. as a salary annually,
during the Rev. Mr. Bigelow's lifetime, and \$650.,
annually after Mr. Bigelow's decease, — — — — —
— after a considerable discussion had, upon the subject
matter of said report, made by their Committee, — the
Question was put, to see, if the Town would accept
of the report of their committee, as by them exhi-
— bited, and it passed in the affirmative, — — — — —
— It was then voted, that the Committee aforesaid be
directed to wait on Mr. Hilliard, to inform him with
the doings of the Town, at this Meeting, for his con-
— sideration; — Then the Town by their vote Disposed
