- 2<sup>d</sup> To bring in their Votes, for the choice of some Suitable Person, for a County Treas<sup>r</sup> for the year ensuing
- 3<sup>d</sup> To fill up Vacancies, in those Town offices, which the Law requires, should any office appear to be Vacant,
- 4<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town, will authorise, their Surveyors of highways, for the year ensuing, to collect the Money, of those who shall refuse, or Neglect, to work out their taxes, when called upon, by their respective Surveyors, to do, or act as the Town shall think best when Met,
- 5<sup>th</sup> To see, if the Town, will agreeable to the request of Mr<sup>r</sup> Marcus Cutler, remit to him his proportionable part of the Money Granted for the Support of public Schools in said Town, to do, or act &c &c
- 6<sup>th</sup> To see, if the Town, will agreeable to the request of Cap<sup>t</sup> Abner Wheeler, take any measures, for fixing upon a suitable time, for the purpose of the Ordination, of Mr<sup>r</sup> Timothy Hilliard, who has agreeably to the encouragement offered him, by the Town, seen fit, to give his answer, to settle with them, in the Gospel Ministry, also to appoint a suitable Number of Persons, as a Committee, or Committees, to conduct, and regulate the prudential Matters relative to said Day, - to do, or act &c &c
- 7<sup>th</sup> To attend to any, or all the reports, to be made by Committees, should any reports, be offered to be made,
- 8<sup>th</sup> To see, if the Town, will act upon the 2<sup>d</sup> article, in the warning of Sept<sup>r</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting, & refer, to the Next Town Meeting, & so on to the Next March Meeting, for further consideration, to do, or act &c &c
