Secure, and safe, from danger, agreeable to their report;

5<sup>th</sup> Article the Town, by their vote, remitted to M<sup>r</sup>. Marcus Cutler his proportionable part of the School Money, as apportioned under this act.

3<sup>d</sup> attended to the report of the Selectmen, who were appointed in March last, for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable Person, or persons to collect the taxes, assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town for the year ensuing; who reported, that they had let out the whole of the collection of taxes, assessed which shall be assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town for the year ensuing, to Lunt. Jesse Moore, for six mills, on the Dollar, Provided he gets good & sufficient bondsmen, to the acceptance of the Town Treas<sup>r</sup>. — Provided also — that he can have the privilege of being chosen Constable for the year ensuing; — which report was accepted, & the Town by their vote, made choice of Lunt. Jesse Moore, for their Constable, for the year ensuing. — who was the same evening, sworn to the faithful discharge of his office, by the Clerk of the Town —

— then M<sup>r</sup>. Gideon Richardson, requested to be excused from serving as one of the School Comm<sup>tee</sup>, but the vote, was negative,

— then M<sup>r</sup>. Elijah Jones excused himself from serving on the School-Committee, and M<sup>r</sup>. Jordan Parmenter was chosen in his stead, —

— made choice of M<sup>r</sup>. Joseph Brigham for Surveyor of Highways, in the N.W. Ward, in the room of M<sup>r</sup>. Joseph Baborn who declined serving, as Surveyor —

4<sup>th</sup> the Town, by their vote, directed their assessors, to furnish each Surveyor, of Highways with a warrant, in due form of law, so as to enable him or them, to collect the Money, of such as shall refuse, or neglect, to work out their taxes when called upon, by their respective Surveyors, &c —

8<sup>th</sup> article, put over to May Meeting, for further consideration —

— then the Town, by their vote, Dissolved this Meeting —
