men of the Town of Sudbury, for the time being, and made
oath, that they would faithfully, and impartially discharge
the duties of their office, as it respects this, and all elections and
the returns thereof.

To Lieut. Jesse Moore, Constable of the Town of Sudbury
in the County of Middlesex. — Greeting

LS You are hereby required in the Name of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts, to notify and warn the male
LS Inhabitants of said Town, being twenty One years of
LS age, & resident in said Town, for the space of one
LS year next preceding, having a freehold Estate within
LS said Town, of the annual Income of three Pounds,
or any Estate to the value of sixty Pounds, to meet
at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday
the 2^d Day of May next, at 1 o'clock in the after-
noon, for the purpose of choosing a Representative
to Represent them in the General Court, appoint-
ed to be convened and held at Boston, on the last
Wednesday of May next.

— Hence you are not to fail of making return of this
warrant, with your doing thereon, to some one of
the Selectmen, Previous to the Opening said Meeting.
