Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified and warn-
ed the Male Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified as therein
expressed to meet, at the the time & place, and for the pur-
poses within Mentioned, — Jesse Moore } Constable —

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the
2^d Day of May 1814. proceeded to the business of said Day (&
after the votes called for, to be brought in, for the choice of
a Representative, to Represent them in the General Court
agreeable to what is expressed under this warrant,) it was
moved & seconded, to see if the Town would send a Repre-
sentative to the General Court as expressed in said warrant
which being put to vote, it passed in the Negative —
Then the Town by their vote, Dissolved, this Meeting —

To Lieut. Jesse Moore Constable of the Town of this
Town of Sudbury, in the County of Middlesex, Greeting
L^s You are hereby required in the name of the Com-
monwealth of Massachusetts, to notify & warn
L^s The Male Inhabitants of said Town being twenty
one years of age and resident in said Town, for the
L^s space of one year next preceding having a free-
L^s hold estate within said Town, of the annual In-
come of three pounds, or any estate to the value
of sixty pounds, to Assemble at the Meeting House
in said Town, on Monday the 23^d Day of May
Instant at 4 o'clock in the afternoon to give
in their votes for one Representative, that is
an Inhabitant of Middlesex district, to Repre-
sent them in the Congress of the United —
