To Lieut. Jesse Moore, Constable of the Town of Sud-
bury, in the County of Middlesex - Greeting -

That you are hereby required in the Name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts to Notify, and
warn, the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Said
Town, Qualified by Law, to Vote, in Town affairs, to
Meet, at the Meeting-House, in Said Town, on
Monday the 2^d Day of May Next, at 2 o'clock
in the afternoon on Said Day, then and there
to act on the following articles, Vizt. -

1st To Choose a Moderator -

2^d To bring in Town Debts, and Credit -

3^d To see, if the Town will Grant, to the Revd. Mr.
Biglow, his Salary, for the year ensuing, to do, or
act as the Town shall think best when Met,

4th To see, if the Town will Grant the Sum of five hun-
dred Dollars (as reported by their Committee &
accepted by the Town) as a Salary to Mr. Timothy
Willard, for the year ensuing - Provided he set-
tles with us as our Minister, to do, or act &c &c

5th To see, if the Town, will Grant five Hundred dol-
lars (it being the Sum reported by their Com-
mittee and accepted by the Town) as a Settlement
to Mr. Timothy Willard, provided he settles with
us as our minister, to do or act &c &c

6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the sup-
port of a Grammar School, for the year ensuing
and order where the same shall be kept, to do,
or act &c &c

7th To see, if the Town will Grant Money, for the
Support of a reading and writing school for
the year ensuing and order where the same
shall be kept, to do, or act, &c &c
