

May Anno Domini 1814.

- 8th To see, if the Town will Grant Money, for the relief of the Poor, belonging to Said Town, for the year ensuing
- 9th To see, if the Town will Grant Money to pay their Fees, and Appraisors, for the present year, to do, or act &c &c.
- 10th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable person, to take care of, and sweep the Meeting House, ring the bell, & dig graves, as occasion may require for the year ensuing to do, or act &c &c.
- 11th To see, if the Town will act upon the 2^d Article in the warranting of Sept 6th Meeting and refer to the next Town Meeting, & so on to April and then to May Meeting for further consideration, to do or act &c &c.
- 12th To see, if the Town, will appoint a Committee for the purpose of draughting an Instrument, to Indemnify the Town from Mr. Timothy Williard, having any right of claim upon the Ministerial lands in Said Town it being agreeable to the wish of Mr. Williard, to do or act, &c &c.
- 13th To see, if the Town will Grant a suitable sum of Money, for the purpose of furnishing Materials sufficient to make the pulpit appear decent &c &c to do or act &c &c.
- 14th To see, if the Town will devise Measures whereby the Inhabitants of Said Town may pass, and repass into the body and Gallery of the Meeting-House upon public and religious days, free from all unnecessary obstructions, to do, or act &c &c.
- 15th To see, if the Town, will discount to Constable Walter Haynes, such Taxes, as he holds against certain persons belonging to said Town, as appear to be unable to pay the same, it being agreeable to the request of Mr. Walter Haynes, to do or act &c &c.
- 16th To see if the Town will Grant a suitable sum of Money for to defray the expense of providing for the entertainment of the counsel and Clergymen &c at the ordination which is to be in June next to do or act &c &c.
