Sudbury Monday September 5th 1814

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on the Day and Year
abovesaid provided to the business of said Day & took up the
1st Article, and made choice of Colo. Jona^a Rice for their Moderator
2^d Voted, to Institute an action, against the Town of Stow, for the
Expense that has arisen, for the support of Jonathan Robinson
and family, — also for ridding themselves from any further
support of said Jona^a & family, (as express in this article) and
the Selectmen, were appointed and authorized in behalf of the
Town, for the purposes aforesaid, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

3^d Granted, the sum of \$33, for the purpose of making
up the Deficiency in the Towns Stock of Ammunition

4th Granted the sum of \$20, to reimburse the several per-
sons, who subscribed, and have paid said sum as a bounty
to the four Soldiers who were Detached the 1st of August last
for the term of three Months unless sooner Discharged — \$20, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

— also voted, to make up said Soldiers, with what Govern-
ment has given the sum of \$12, per Month, — also —

— Granted, the sum of \$20, for the purpose of making up
to said Soldiers the sum of \$12, per Month, — \$20, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

— Also voted, to give by way of encouragement, the same
Bounty, in proportion to the time, to those Soldiers, who it is said are
about to be called for, and to make them up the same pay
by the Month, as those four Men have had Granted, who are al-
ready detached into the service ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

— Granted the sum of \$5, for to purchase a Blank Book
for recording the proceedings of Town Meetings — in the present
record Book being filled about up — — — — \$5, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

— Then the Town by their Vote, Dissolved this
Meeting —
