or any Estate to the Value of Sixty Pounds to
Assemble at the Meeting-House in said Town on
Monday the 7th Day of November next, at
1 o'clock, in the afternoon, to give in their Votes
for a Representative of the People of said Com-
monwealth in the Congress of the United States,
for the Middlesex district, ~
