To Lieut. Jesse Moore, Constable of the Town of
Sudbury, in the County of Middlesex - Greeting.
You are hereby required in the Name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify and
warn, the freeholders, and other Inhabitants of
the Town of Sudbury, Qualified by Law, to vote
in Town Meetings, to assemble at the Meeting-
house in said Town, on Monday the 16th
Day of January Instant, at 1 o'clock in the af-
ternoon, on said Day, then and there to act
on the following articles vizt -

1st To Choose a Moderator,
2^d To see, if the Town, will, agreeable to the request of
Mr. Bery Rice, take any Measures for the pur-
pose of assisting him in discharging a bill of
cost, which Lieut. Peter Smith, has obtained
against said Rice in consequence of a suit in-
stituted by said Smith, against said Rice, for his
right in the Estate, of which Lieut. Israel Smith
did seized of - as also respecting a certain bond
which the Inhabitants of said Town hold, against
said Rice, for the sum of \$515. 94, with Inter-
est, to do, or act, as the Town shall think pro-
per when met

3^d To See, if the Town, will take any, & if any, what
Measures they will take, for the purpose of securing
to the Inhabitants of said Town, the Debt and bill
of cost, which Mr. John Richardson, obtained against
the Town, for the support of Lieut. Peter Smith
whilst confined in Concord Goal, some time since
