can be obtained) sufficient to reimburse the Interest which
has been paid upon said Bond and the selectmen were
appointed, and authorized ^{in behalf of the Town} for the purposes aforesaid —

3^d Then the Town by their vote, directed their selectmen
to take the Opinion of some able attorney in law,
respecting the demand the Town holds against Lieut.
Peter Smith, for a Debt & bill of cost, which the Town
paid for said Smith as express in this article — and
if there is encouragement given, of sundering in
obtaining the demand, for to Institute an action as
soon as possible, and to report to the Town, of
their doings at the next Month Meeting —

4th Vote to appoint one Man as a Comm^{tee} for to Dispose
of the School-House mentioned in this article, & Capt.
Asahel Wheeler was appointed to perform that Service

2^d & 5th Then the Town by their vote, Granted to Mr. Ben-
jamin Rie, the sum of — \$100 .. for to com-
pensate him the bill of cost, which Lt. Peter
Smith obtained against him, and ordered that
the same should be made into a tax, with the other
Grants which shall be made at the next debt and
credit meeting — — — — — \$100 ..
