6th To see, if the Town will grant Money for the support of a Reading and writing school, for the year ensuing and Order where the same shall be kept, to do, or act, &c.

7th To see, if the Town will grant Money, for the relief of the Poor, belonging to said Town, for the year ensuing.

8th To see, if the Town will grant Money, to pay their Treas^r and Officers for the present year, to do - or act &c.

9th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable person, to take care of, and sweep the Meeting-House, ring the Bell, and Dig graves, as Occasion may require, for the year ensuing, to do - or act &c.

10th To see, if the Town, will discount to Constable Walter Haynes, such taxes as he holds, against certain persons which appear to be unable to pay the same, to do, or act, &c.

11th To see, if the Town, will accept of a road, as laid out, by the Selectmen, from the County road, Near Mr. Bay^r Smiths, through said Smiths land, to the Mill, belonging to Mr. Asa Smith, it being for the accommodation of the public and agreeable, to the Petition of Mr. Asa Smith, reference thereunto being had, to do - or act &c.

12th To see, if the Town will take any measures for to repair their Meeting-House, in such parts of said house as shall appear to be necessary to be repaired, to do - or act &c.

13th To see, if the Town, will grant, or appropriate, a suitable sum of Money, for the purpose of making good their engagements, to this Towns proportion of Soldiers, which were detached in Sept. last, for the term of three months to do - or act &c.

14th To see if the Town, will attend, to any, or all the reports to be made by Committees, should any reports be offered to be made, to do, or act, &c.
