To Mr. Walter Haynes, Constable, of the Town of Sudbury,
in the County of Middlesex

Greeting

Le. You are hereby required, in the Name of the Com=
mon-wealth of Massachusetts, to Notify, and warn,
Le. the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants of said Town, Qua=
lified by law, to Vote, in Town affairs, to assemble at
Le. the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the 26th
Le. Day of June, Instant, at 2 o'clock, in the afternoon,
on said day, then and there, to act on the following
articles, Vizt.

1st To Choose a Moderator,
2^d To see if the Town, will take ~~any~~ measures for the
~~consideration~~ purpose of taking into their serious con=
sideration, the difficulties that are apparently exist=
ing between the Rev^d. Mr. Hilliard and the Inhabi=
tants of said Town, it being agreeable to the Peti=
tions of Mr. Isaac Puffer, and Others, reference there=
unto being had, to do, or act, as the Town shall
think best when met,
And you are not to fail of making return of this War=
rant, with your doings thereon, to some one of the
Selectmen, previous to the opening said Meeting.

bury this 17th day of June A.D. 1815
