Sudbury Monday June 26, 1815, —

At a Town meeting legally held, in Sudbury on the Day and Year above mentioned, provided to the business of said day, and took up the 1st article and made
1st Choice of William Hunt Esq. for their Moderator, —

2^d article, after a considerable discussion had upon the subject matter of this article, — the Question was put to see, if the Town would act upon this article and it passed in the affirmative —

It was then voted to appoint a Committee for the purpose of conferring with the Rev. Mr. Hilliard upon the subject matter of this article said Committee to consist of five, and to be chosen by ballot, and the following Gentlemen were chosen, V^{ice} Col. Rice Deacon Rogers, Mr. Isaac Puffer Mr. John Goodnow Jr. and Capt. Erskine — also by their vote, directed said Committee to confer with the Rev. Mr. Hilliard respecting a separation from his people and upon what terms, — and to report to the Town, at the adjournment of this Meeting, their doings, if adjourned, —

It was then voted, to adjourn this Meeting to this day fortnight at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, to meet at this place, —

The Town being met, at time and place, agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, provided, and took up the 2^d article in the warning of this Meeting, and attended to the report of the Committee who were appointed for the purpose of conferring with the Rev. Mr. Hilliard, respecting a separation from
