- 1st To Choose a Moderator,
 - 2^d To see, if the Town will take measures for the purpose
of procuring some suitable person, to supply this Desk,
during the Towns Pleasure, to do, or act, as the Town
shall think best when met;
 - 3^d To see, if the Town, will take some suitable Measures
for the purpose of making, any addition to their bu-
rying yard, - to do, or act any other way on this
article that they may think proper when met, -
it being agreeable to the request of Mr. Asa Royce,
 - 4th To see, if the Town will, agreeable to the request of Mr.
Timothy Willard, Grant him a sufficient Sum of
Money to pay the Interest, upon the balance due, on
his Salary and Settlement, from the time it became
due, up to the present date, to do, or act &c &c
