last, for the purpose of procuring some suitable person, or persons to preach from that time untill the next march Meeting) any further directions respecting what proportion of time they should think proper, not to hire preaching, to do, or act, on this article, as the Town shall think best when met,

3^d To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of enabling their collectors for the future, to collect the taxes apportioned upon the Inhabitants of said Town, in such a manner as will enable them, more speedily to meet all the demands that shall be made by the respective Treasurers, to do, or act, &c. &c.

4th To see, if the Town will take any measures, for the purpose of procuring a stove, for the School-House in the Centro district, as also for a stove, for the School-House in the North-west District in said Town, and Grant a suitable sum of Money for purchasing the same, to do - or act &c. &c.

5th To see, if the Town will appoint a Committee to join with a Committee, which are about being appointed by the Inhabitants of East Sudbury, for the purpose of Petitioning the Legislature of this Commonwealth, for a Lottery, to raise the long & short Causeways in said Towns, it being agreeable to the request of Capt. Jilly Smith and others, to do or act &c. &c.

6th To see, if the Town will appropriate, (out of the execution, said Town has obtained against the Inhabitants of East Sudbury,) a sum of money sufficient, to answer the demands the County Treas^r holds against the Inhabitants of Sudbury, for their proportion of a County tax, for the year 1813, which warrant for the Affirmment of the same, through neglect, in the clerk of the Court, or by miscarriage, was not conveyed to the assessors of said Town, untill within a few days past, to do, or act &c. &c.
