Pursuant to the within warrant, I have notified the
Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Sudbury aforesaid to
meet, at the time and place, & for the purposes within
mentioned

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on Monday the
18th Day of Decr 1815, provided ^{to} the business of said day
and took up the 1st article, & made choice of William Hunt
Esq^r for their Moderator,

2^d Article after some discussion had upon the subject matter of
this article, - The Question was put to see if the Town would
pass over this article for the present, which being put to
Vote, it passed in the affirmative,

3^d Then the Town took up this article, and after some time spent
upon the subject matter of this article, it was voted, to appoint
a Committee, (for the purpose of making a draught of cer-
tain articles, which they should think proper, in order to ena-
ble their collectors, ^{for the future} to enforce the collection of their taxes more
speedily,) as expressed in this article, - and to make their report
to the Town, at the next March Meeting, - Said Commit-
tee to consist of three, and the following Gent^l^{en} were chosen
Viz^t Mr. Asahel Whaler Jun^r, Eben^r Plympton Esq^r, & William
Hunt Esq^r and for the purpose above mentioned

2^d Then the Town took up this article again, and the Question was
put to see, if the Town would give any directions to their Com-
mittee which were appointed for the purpose of procuring some
suitable person to preach until March Meeting, which being put
to Vote, it passed in the Negative.

4th Voted not to act upon this article

5th Voted to appoint a Committee, for the purposes expressed in
this article, said Committee to consist of three, and the follow-
ing Persons were chosen, Viz^t Darius Maynard, William Hunt
Esq^r, and Mr. Asahel Whaler Jun^r - & for the purposes aforesaid.
