7th To see, if the Town will Grant money, to pay their Treas^r and Officers, for the Present year, to do or act &c &c

8th To see if the Town will grant a suitable sum of Money for the purpose of hiring preaching for the year ensuing, to do or act &c &c

9th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable person to take care of Sweep the meeting House, ring the bell & dig graves, as Occasion may require, for the year ensuing, to do, or act &c &c

10th To see, if the Town will agreeable to the request of Mr. Thomas R. Plympton, exempt him from being taxed, to the Highway taxes, untill such time as he shall have a Town road opened to his land to do or act &c &c

11th To see, if the Town will appropriate, (out of the money which the Town obtained against the Inhabitants of East Sudbury, in their late law suit, respecting the Sup^r port of the widow Elizabeth Rice) a sum sufficient to answer the Balance of orders, due Mr. Benjamin Dudley, which he holds against the Town upon the Grant of 1814, to do, or act &c &c

12th To see, if the Town, will accept of the list of Jurors as presented, by the Selectmen, to do or act &c &c

13th To see, if the Town will give any encouragement to such persons, as shall use the means of destroying Crows, within limits of said Town, it being agreeable to the request of Lieut Bogle, to do, or act &c &c

14th To see, if the Town will discount to Constable Jesse Moore, such taxes, as he holds against certain persons in said Town, as shall appear unable to pay the same, to do or act &c &c

15th To see, if the Town, will accept of a road (if it should be laid out by the Selectmen, from the
