Company, reference therunto being had, to do or act &c.

16th To see, if the Town, will call on the several Survey-
ors of Highways for the year 1815, to see if they have
expended all the money on their several limits
committed to them, to amend and repair, to do or act.

17th To see, if the Town will act on the 10th article in
the warning of March meeting and refer'd to
April, and so on to May Meeting for further con-
sideration, to do or act &c.

18th To see, if the Town will attend to any or all the
reports to be made by Committees, should any
reports be offer'd, to do or act, &c.

19th To see, if the Town, will take any measures for
the purpose of keeping in repair for the future
the one half of the Bridge (as far as stone line)
that is already built by M^r. Asa Smith across
Elizabeth river (so call'd) it being agreeable to the
request of said Smith, to do, or act &c.

Hereof you are not to fail of making re-
turn of this warrant with your doings
thereon, to some One of the Selectmen pre-
vious to the opening said meeting.
