At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on the Day and

N.B. The above grant to the Rev. Mr. Bigelow, was reconsidered
Sept. 30th following

4th Granted, for the support of a Grammar School, for the
year ensuing, the sum of \$375. to be equally divi-

5th Granted, for the support of a reading and writing
School, for the year ensuing the sum of \$125.
to be equally divided between the five school
districts

= also Granted the sum of \$25. for the supply-
ing the several school districts with wood to
be equally divided between said districts.

6th Granted for the support of the poor, belonging
to said Town, for the year ensuing, the sum of \$200.00

7th Voted that the Treas^r at the close of the year
bring in his bill for his services, both for Treas^r
and Collectors services, and then the Town to ad-
just said bill that he shall be reasonably
paid for said services

= Granted to pay their Assessors for the present
year the sum of \$20.00
