The Town being met, at time & place agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, provided & took up the first article and made choice of William Hunt Esq^r for their moderator, Instead of Mr. Asahel Wheeler Jr. Deceased. — Then proceeded to the business of said day & took up the

10th Article and passed over said article, Not to be acted upon. — Then voted to adjourn this meeting, for one hour on the account of their Committees, which were appointed to examine accounts not being present to exhibit their report on accounts.

At the expiration of One hour, the Town being again assembled, proceeded, to the business of said day by attending to the report of their committee appointed for the purpose of examining the stove in the Northwest district School-House, which report was laid on the table, & read before the Town, and was by their Vote accepted, and is as follows, Viz^t "We the subscribers being a committee appointed for the purpose of viewing the stove in the Northwest School House have attended that service, and beg leave to report, that their Opinion is the stove may be made good with a very little expence, it is their Opinion the difficulty they complain of is principally owing to the chimney not being big enough
