Such repairs as they have reported, & exhibit their account to the Committee for adjusting accounts, in order for allowance, &c.

Then Voted to adjourn this Meeting to the last Monday in September Instant, at 4 o'clock in the afternoon, to meet at the place,

Sudbury Monday Sept^r 30, 1816,

The Town being met, at time & place agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, provided to the business of said day - adjourn this Meeting for half an hour (it being for the special purpose) for the Committee, appointed to examine accounts, to complete their business, in order to lay before the Town,

The Town being assembled, agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, provided & took up the 2^d article & allowed accounts, as follows Vot^d for the funeral expense of the Rev^d M^r Bigelow as per accounts, as they stand hereafter recorded.

3^d The Town took up this article again, & by their vote, reconsidered the grant, to the Rev^d M^r Bigelow, which was made under this article in May last, - & Grant- ed the sum of thirty dollars, to the wid^d Elizabeth Bigelow, & family, to compensate them for the surplus of supplying the pulpit, over the expirations of the term of time for the last year, being given by the Rev^d Clergy, to the wid^d &c of their Deceased Pastor, - \$30⁰⁰

Granted, the sum of \$250⁰⁰ for the purpose of making up the deficiency, arising in consequence of the discounts on the Taxes, to those persons who shall pay them, agreeable to their Com^{tee}s report & the Towns concurrence in it, sum - \$250⁰⁰

Granted, to pay the Interest, upon the Note Given to Mr. Walter Haynes, for the burying yard ground ~~not~~ purchased of him, the sum of - \$16⁰⁰
