It was then Voted, (at the request of Deacon Puffer) to set apart, a Day, for fasting, humiliation and Prayer, to the Supreme Governor of the Universe, for his direction, & guidance, in those measures, which shall be most conducive to the harmonizing us, in the re-establishment of a gospel Minister amongst us.

also voted to appoint a Committee, to consist of three for the purpose of procuring the Ministers, to attend on said Day, to preach the Sermons and perform all other divine services, — and Deacon Haynes, & Col. Rice was chosen — then Col. Rice, excused himself from serving, & Dr. Puffer, was chosen in his room, Ruben Maynard, then Ruben Maynard, excused himself from serving on said Comtee, & Mr. Paul Walker, was chosen in his stead — also Voted that the first Thursday after the 3^d day of Nov^r be set apart for holding
