To Mr. ~~Walter Heyman~~ John Brown, Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex, — Greeting. —
— you are hereby required in the Name of the Common-wealth
of Massachusetts, to Notify and warn, the Freeholders and other Inhabi-
tants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified by Law, to Vote, in Town Affairs,
to Meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday the 10th day
of June Instant, at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, on said day then
and there to act on the following articles Viz:

- 1st To Choose a Moderator,
- 2^d To see, if the Town will take any Measures for the purpose of
hiring Mr. Rufus Hurlbut, and any other person, or persons,
(that are Candidates for preaching) that the Church & Town, may
agree upon, to preach with them on Probation, — it being agree-
able to certain votes, passed by the Church of Christ, in this
place, on the 30th day of May last past, reference thereto being
had, to do or act, any other way on this article, as the Town
shall think best when met,
- 3^d To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable person, as
(a Committee man for hiring preaching) Instead of Mr. Asa-
hel Wheeler Jun^r, recently deceased, to do or act on
- 4th To see, if the Town, will grant Money to purchase cloath-
sufficient to make a decent burying Cloath, for the use of
said Town, to do or, act &c &c
- 5th To see, if the Town will appoint a Committee, for the pur-
pose of applying to the Rev^d Mr. Adams, and request of
him a copy of the Sermon, preached at the funeral
of ~~the~~ Asahel Wheeler Jun^r for to be committed to the press
for publication, it being agreeable to the request of Lieut.
Justice Willis, to do, or act, &c &c
- 6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to purchase a stone
for the School-House, in the North west district, to do, or
(act &c &c)
- 7th To see, if the Town, will take any measures for the
purpose of keeping in repair for the future, the one
half of the Bridge (as far as to Stow line) that is already
built
