Middlesex To Mr. John Brown, Constable of the Town of Sudbury in
the County of Middlesex, Greeting,
- you are hereby required, in the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts, to notify & warn, the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified by law, to vote, in Town of-
- fairs, to meet at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday
the 2^d Day of Sept^r next, at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, on
said day, then & there, to act on the following articles vizt -

- 1st To Choose a Moderator,
- 2^d To see, if the Town, will give their Committee (which were ap-
- pointed on the 15th July last,) for the purpose of procuring
- preaching in said Town, during the Towns pleasure, any fur-
- ther directions respecting their proceedings in said business, to
do, or act, as the Town shall think best when met,
- 3^d To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the purpose of
- creating a sufficient Number of lots, in the most convenient
- place, in front of the burying yard in said Town, for the pur-
- pose of fastening Houses too, as Occasion may require, & also to
- give directions if they see fit, to order the leveling the ground
in front of said burying yard, to do - or, act, &c &c
- And if you are not to fail of making return of this war-
- rant with your doings, thereon, to some one of the select-
- men previous to the opening said Meeting
- Given under our hand, and seals at said Sudbury this 1st

At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the
2^d Day of September, 1816, provided & took up the 1st article &
1st made choice of Mr. Micah Balcom, for their Moderator, -
2^d Article the Question was put, to see, if the Town, would appoint
their old Com^{tee} mentioned under this article, for to stand, as a New Com^{tee}
36 & it passed in the affirmative, - then the Town by their vote recon-
- sidered the vote last past, - and then voted, that the Commit-
- tee mentioned in this article be authorized, &c to act as they
shall think most proper with regard to providing such per-
- son, or persons to preach, as they shall think most suitable,
&c -
