Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday the 30th Day of
September Instant, at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, then &
there to act on the following articles Viz -

1st To Choose a Moderator,
2^d To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable sum of Mo:
ney, for the purpose of enabling, their singing society, to pro:
cure some suitable person to teach a singing school in
said Town the present fall, it being agreeable to the request
of said society, to do or act, as the Town shall think best
when met,

3^d To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable sum of Money
for the purpose of opening & making the road lately laid
out in the northerly part of said Town, leading through
the lands of Mr. Hunting & Co., to do or act, &c &c
