Sudbury Monday September, 30th 1816.

At a Town meeting, legally held in Sudbury, on the Day & year
above said, provided to the business of said Day, & made choice of
William Hunt Esq. for their moderator,

2^d Article Granted the sum of \$30.00 for the purpose of hiring
some suitable person to teach a singing school in said Town, also
voted to choose a Committee, to consist of three, for the purpose
of hiring some suitable person, to teach said school, & to attend
to all matters respecting the ordering & Managing thereof, and the
following persons were chosen Viz. Dea. Puffer, Mr. Abel Wheeler,
& Capt. Israel Haynes, — then Capt. Haynes, excused himself, from
serving on said committee, and Mr. Martin Brown, was cho-
sen in his stead, — \$30.00

— Then voted, to adjourn this Meeting for one hour, & take up the
warrant for May Meeting —

— The Town again resumed their Meeting, agreeable to the fore-
going adjournment, provided and took up the —

3^d Article & Granted the sum of \$50.00 for the making the
Road mentioned in this article — \$50.00

— also voted to appoint a Committee for the purpose of laying
out the money, and superintending the making the road (men-
tioned in this article) to the best advantage to said Town
said Committee to consist of three, and the following were
chosen, Viz. Dea. Puffer, Capt. Gibbs, & Mr. William May, —
then Dea. Puffer, & Capt. Gibbs excused themselves from ser-
ving on said committee, and Mr. Joseph Brigham, &
Mr. Loring Wheeler were chosen in their steads, —

— also Granted, to Mr. Abiel Smith, the sum of twenty
Dollars, to compensate him for the land taken from him
for making the Highway, in addition to the Grant at
May Meeting, it being in full of his demands for the
road passing through his lands — \$20.00

— Then the Town by their vote dissolved
this meeting — William Hunt Moderator
